1. *Members:*  
Increasing the number of members.
2. *Networks:*  
Further developing and strengthening the networks, particularly the communication within the networks
3. *PhD. Students:*  
Increasing the involvement of PhD students and young researchers in the annual congresses. The structure of congress costs will be reconsidered.
4. *Web-site:*  
Continuous updating and further development of the web-site.
5. *Policy for the future:*  
Continue the efforts to elaborate the policy for the future of the association in relation to new conditions, particularly concerning publication and economy.
6. *International activities:*  
To maintain and further elaborate contacts with international Educational research Associations, like EERA and AERA.  
Collaborating with EERA in developing a European educational quotation system (CRISS) and in establishing the Pedagogical and Educational Research Information Network for Europe ([www.dipf.de/perine/](http://www.dipf.de/perine/))..
7. *Nordisk Pedagogik:*  
Further development of the quality and making Nordisk Pedagogik even more public through continuing expanding the number of pages.
