

ANNUAL REPORT FOR *NORDIC STUDIES IN EDUCATION*, VOLUME 35

From December 2014, Herner Saeverot has been the editor-in-chief of NSE, while Dziuginta Baraldsnes has functioned as editorial secretary. The Editorial Board has met twice during 2015; in Gothenburg in March 2015, and in Helsinki in August 2015.

20 articles were published in 2015, in four issues, of which the last one was a double issue (3-4 2015). The reason for publishing issue 3 and 4 together had to do with a slightly economic problem. This situation has now improved.

78 articles were submitted in 2015. 34 of the submitted articles were forwarded for peer review. 12 articles have been accepted for publication, and 6 have been rejected after review. 15 manuscripts remain to be reviewed, and 1 paper has been withdrawn. In addition, six manuscripts have been accepted for publication as a special issue (2-2016). The editor did not coordinate the review process for this issue.

As shown in table 1, there is an increase of 15 submitted manuscripts compared to 2014 (63 submitted manuscripts). The number of editorial rejects is pretty much the same as the previous year, as there is still need for reducing the accumulating build-up of accepted articles waiting to be published. 14 volumes (2002 – 2015) of *Nordic Studies in Education* are now fully accessible on the web, through Universitetsforlaget's database www.idunn.no.
