

ANNUAL REPORT FOR *NORDIC STUDIES IN EDUCATION*, VOLUME 36

Herner Saeverot (Western Norway University) has been the editor-in-chief of NSE from December 2014, while Dziuginta Baraldsnes (Western Norway University) has functioned as editorial secretary. The Editorial Board has met twice during 2016; in Helsinki in March 2016, and in Copenhagen in August 2016.

19 articles were published in 2016, in four issues, of which issue 2 was a special issue on the theme educational leadership in the Nordic countries. 70 articles were submitted in 2016. 32 of the submitted articles were forwarded for peer review. 22 articles have been accepted for publication, and 6 have been rejected after review. 4 manuscripts remain to be reviewed. In addition, four manuscripts have been accepted for publication as a special issue (2-2017). The editor did not coordinate the review process for this issue.

As shown in table 1, there is a decrease of 8 submitted manuscripts compared to 2015 (78 submitted manuscripts). The number of editorial rejects has also decreased compared to the previous year. The number of editorial rejections is still relatively high, as there is still need for reducing the accumulating build-up of accepted articles waiting to be published. 15 volumes (2002 – 2016) of *Nordic Studies in Education* are now fully accessible on the web, through Universitetsforlaget's database www.idunn.no.
